

## First Grade Online Lessons

### May 18-26:

#### Reading:

- Students will read “A Tree Is a Plant”, the electronic version, Book 5, Lesson 24, pages 121-147, from the teacher district webpage. Please remember the password is tigers for the reading book.
- We are going to listen for a vowel sound found in some of the words in our story. The sound we are looking for is the /oo /sound. Say the word noon and listen to the vowel sound. I have underlined the letters that make the vowel sound in each word. Also, this sound is found in these words: soup, glue, cute. Find three examples of words with the /oo/ sound in “A Tree Is a Plant.” List those three words.
- Challenge: Write a sentence using at least two of the words you listed.

#### Kid Writing:

- Think about the story, “A Tree Is a Plant”. Pretend you are going on a hike to an apple tree and back. Write a story telling us about your trip to the apple tree and back. Tell what happened in the beginning, middle, and end of your story.
- Challenge: Reread your writing piece and check for capitals, punctuation, spelling, and spaces. Make any corrections needed.

- Think about your first-grade school year. Draw a picture of what you will remember about first grade.
- Challenge: Write a few sentences to tell us about what you will remember about first grade.
