### **Community:**

The community served by the Fannett-Metal School District is a remote, rural area in northwestern Franklin County, Pennsylvania. The district lies on either side of Pennsylvania State Route 75 between two mountains in the Tuscarora Mountain range and is more than 25 miles from an urbanized area. There are two buildings in the District: Elementary is Pre-K through 5<sup>th</sup> grade and Middle/High school is 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

### **School:**

The Fannett-Metal High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school with a student population of less than 200 students in grades 9-12. Ninety-eight percent of the student population classify themselves as white. The average class size is 12 students.

### **Curriculum:**

The academic program consists of classes on a year-long schedule. Most students are enrolled in traditional period courses. Students who attend the Franklin County Career and Technology Center may earn half credit for courses they take during their semester at Fannett-Metal. Eight and one half (8.5) credits per year is the maximum class load.

Sophomores who will have successfully met credit requirements for core courses are eligible to apply to attend the Franklin County Career and Technology Center for the spring semester of their junior year and fall semester of their senior year. Fannett-Metal schedules for these students are highly individualized.

Early-to-College classes are offered to junior and senior students from several colleges. Juniors may take online courses while seniors have the option to take online or on-campus courses. In the 2021-2022 school year, most students chose to access online courses through Allegany College of Maryland due to grant funding covering the cost of tuition, general fees, and textbooks. One student chose to take courses through Harrisburg Area Community College. In the past, students have also attended on-campus classes through Wilson College, on-campus and online classes through Shippensburg University, and online classes through a variety of other colleges/universities including California University of Pennsylvania, Blue Ridge Community College, and Hagerstown Community College.

**Class Rank:**

Class rank is calculated by the use of the final grade percent earned in each class. Beginning with grade 9, all classes, whether passed or failed, are included in this calculation with the exception of Chorus and Band. Class rank is based on a 4.0-point scale. Final class rank is available only after final grades for the graduating class are received by the office.

**Grade Point Average:**

GPA is computed using the final grade percent of each course. A minimum of 27 credits are required for graduation. Grades earned at Fannett-Metal, as well as from other institutions and the Early to College program, are recorded on the transcript. College level courses are computed on a weighted scale (1.2).

**Class of 2022:**

There were 39 graduates in the Class of 2022. 18 students, or 47%, were planning to attend a post-secondary institution. 19 students planned to seek employment following graduation. This is consistent with the increase in post-secondary enrollment over the past 5 years.

**Class of 2022 Standardized Tests Results (Fewer students than average tested due to COVID-19, although there was a slight increase from the past year):**

15% of the class (6 students) took the SAT
