Science in Grade 2

In our new science unit, Changes, students are introduced to the concept that matter exists in three states- solid, liquid and gas. Students will explore how matter changes, including freezing, evaporation, melt-

ing and condensation. Some changes, students will learn, happen quickly and some take time.

Students will learn about mixtures as they combine different sets of solids and liquids, observe the changes,

and discover how to separate the mixtures using such processes as sieving, filtration, evaporation, and chromatography.
