## A. LIU Internet Agreement

The district will pay approximately \$6,510.24 annually after e-rate discount is applied.

### B. LIU 12 General Operating Budget

Approval is sought for the proposed 2024-2025 Lincoln Intermediate Unit's General Operating Budget totaling \$8,421,785 which is an <u>increase</u> in expenditures of \$218,604 from 2023-2024. Fannett-Metal's share will be \$1,049.49 which is an increase of \$11.13.
